There will be Spot Prizes, Challenges, Games and Activities that support children to take risks in Mathematics and build a positive attitude and a love of numbers.

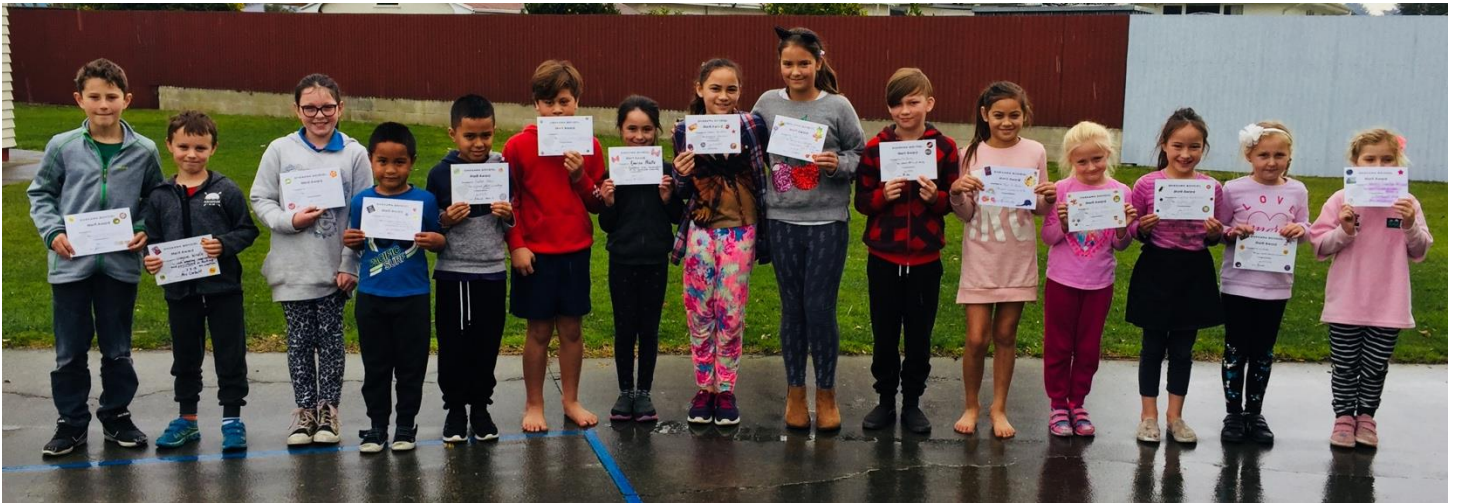
